What should I bring?

You should bring the following items:

- Sleeping bags
- Thermarests
- Cooking gear
- Food
- Candles
- Flashlight
- Toilet paper
- Dish soap
- Fuel for the Coleman propane camp stove and lantern
- Fire starter (newspaper)
- GPS coordinates

For water, you can either melt snow or bring an ice auger to drill a hole in the lake.

Some simple rules:

When dumping dishwater or other used water, dump it behind and to the right of the tent. That way kids won't fall or play in dirty snow.

- Leave some kindling wood for the next user.
- Sweep before you leave.
- Remove ALL garbage, including any leftover food.
- Empty out water pot (important because it may freeze and crack the pot).
- Empty ash from the stove if full and put it in the outhouse.
- Zip up the tent.
