Round table introductions and welcome

Meeting Chair - Toby (vp in lieu of president)

1. Call to Order and Opening Remarks by the Chair

2. Consent Agenda (approval of past minutes)

- approval of last meeting minutes (May 2018?)
- Need to confirm and approve at next meeting

3. Discussion Items

- 3.1 Welcome new Board (Toby, 20 mins)
- 3.2 Events (incl snow show update)
 - SNOW SHOW UPDATE (Shawn?)
 - snow show silent auction has been organized by me, but generally HP parents (70% of proceeds for program)
 - our parent numbers are way down, and need to bring this to Board's attention (parents bring in the big donations)
 - still interested in running the auction, but want to float that auction may not happen this year...
 - need a board contact person to keep updated on this -> Kerry
 - KW: idea to contact kids potentially moving into HP from Track Attack? ->don't want to go there
 - KW: so need to solicit businesses (e.g. those of previous parents)
 - CJ: what are the numbers from this event (percentage of total revenue) and do we know where this money goes ->not sure of percentage, but is biggest fundraiser
 - TH: don't know where it's allocated
 - YJ: how much is this typically? -> 6-7K;
 - CJ: why I ask is if the HP program will survive despite this revenue (or will they be looking for the club to subsidize)? -> no, parents make up costs regardless;
 - looking for 6 or 7 more families to help with the event

- CJ: might want to solicit families who are members and have connections to local businesses -> need to make this search transparent so not to duplicate;
- SR: do we need to talk to Steven if soliciting past Track Attack families? -> CJ: maybe target families who participate in most club activities (30%) generally, not just Track Attack folks; John will help
- EVENTS CALENDAR a few dates not yet set;
- Ski Duathlon April 14th idea of having fat-biking on the lake too (Mark to talk to Mike Argue);
- Intro to Community Coach Workshop and Community Coach Workshop dates still up in the air asked to split costs last year (in which case will have to work with them more), contact is Melanie;
- events calendar is provided to our insurer, and so any changes need to go to CCNWT;
- JS: need to approve list -> wait until next meeting when dates are confirmed;
- JS: Chalet booking needs to go on events list too (e.g. Mon-Fri is open to rentals

 weekend days require reservations (e.g. Saturday nights can be open to
 reserve as long as clean up for Sunday); KW: will need another calendar to not
 have events conflicts;
- contract cleaner (R3 cleaning) when needed, and YES volunteers Mondays and Fridays, may need to fill cleaning gaps after heavy use (e.g Sunday nights before Monday rentals); might not need YES on Monday then...; or YES could do downstairs and snow shovelling only on Mondays
- 3.3 Sunday lunches at the Ski Club (Kerry, 10 mins)
 - every Sunday in Jan/Feb; need to advertise more!
 - lots of vendor interest
 - need process for vendors to apply and select dates (some Sundays following/before events are great gigs)
 - Toby to help Kerry with coordination and potentially contracts (incl. expectations for volunteers, disposables, etc.);
 - need to apply for commercial licence; vendors pay \$100;

3.4 Chalet Renos Update (Tania, 10 mins)

- things are mostly wrapped up; total spent \$267094.17 (under budget by ~\$300)
- HP locker rooms can be accessed with same key as Coaches room and kids doors -> could have new code locks on those doors (or make the program pay for it themselves)
- couches were donated, and might want to budget for new ones down the road
- need one more photo for a full size picture upstairs (smaller one to come downstairs)
- stove not in the budget for now;

- might need a bigger hot water tank -> terraX is willing to buy this, but need to approach them asap
- any more reporting commitments for financial records? -> TH: yes, and will approve this as closed;
- CH: water cooler? -> could just have tank cleaned?; thoughts?; mixed....
- need better road signage

3.5 Treasurer's Update (Tania, 10 mins)

- nothing much to report here;
- rentals have brought in a lot of money
- income to date is 16K (from May 1 Sept 31);
- CJ: need to change signatories at the bank (need two on all cheques) VP, President, Secretary and Treasurer

3.6 Fees (Mark, 10 mins)

- revisiting membership fee schedule
- historically haven't changed since 2013, and only two options (family and individual - youth = adults)
- e.g. in 08' fee revenue was 43K compared to last year's 522 members and less revenue;
- similar size clubs have higher family and individual fees; could increase these marginally to get an extra \$7K in revenue
- SR: so increase would be set for a few years? -> yes, and good time to do it with the newly reno'd facilities;
- TK: would we want to approve this now? -> now is the time people are looking at signing up; SR: not program fees too? -> no; CJ: what about drop in trail fees increase? -> this one is probably overdue;
- CJ: revenue from increasing fees gives flexibility to subsidize other things (e.g. free rentals); would need to update the policy if fees change
- CJ: always think strategically about where/why we're increasing fees

3.7 Promoting the Ski Club

- fall is big promotion time; like to ask if there are any people we want to target? ->

 e.g. Indigenous membership;
- MCP -> JTFN families, and standing offer for community recreation program (sponsor) subsidizing JTFN free memberships; CJ: they are a little underrepresented because we don't always get physical signups (e.g. at snow show);
- Sara to join Steve for coffee with JTFN contact (Rob Matthews);
- Diep: what about similar relationship with other big employers (e.g. GNWT) -> could advertise on Bearfax; visitor's center advertising;

3.8 Appoint Rep to CCNWT (Toby, 5 mins)

- Club has one member appointed; sort of our umbrella organization (insured with them), along with Cross-Country Canada (national); rep would act as interface between our board and CCNWT;
- John volunteers

3.9 Broken Ski Award, Green Family (John, 5 mins)

- TK: is this done ad hoc, or once a year? -> generally want to catch people before they leave
- separate from member appreciation, customary not policy

3.10 Biathlon? (Toby, 5 mins)

- trying to get a re-cert, but no records of it...;
- still need to do a survey of the range
- need a biathlon contact (Bob Reed, Ted Kimmins?);
- SR: need to find a biathlon coach -> CJ: will look for some names; KW: maybe Paul has a successor in mind;
- JS: need a range officer too; TK: happy to take on range officer too; TH: Rob Matthews? -> SR will ask him
- 3.11 Uniforms (Steve, 1 min)
 - two companies (SWIX, CRAFT) we've been dealing with have delayed until September
 - should be fine to get these done on time (only 8-10 HP kids)
 - will update at next meeting
- 3.12 Board Vacancies (Toby, 5 mins)
 - still need President and Facilities Manager;
 - CJ: a few options for filling President position...
 - TK: anyone for Facilities (responsible for all buildings, and have a "web of work" team)?
 - need to put together a team to complete work (even in absence of manager)
 - TH can "act" as manager with John;
 - CJ: recruitment is challenging, and folks can come in to meetings and participate informally (which may lead to filling positions);
 - KW: can we assign someone to look through list of past members for ideas -> TK will take a look; SR: is there a downside to not having a President? -> CJ: rotating chair can help share the burden, and can be beneficial; exec council can also form committee to get things done; no real downside to not having it filled

4.1 Motion to increase 2018/19 club membership fees (Motion: Mark, Second: Chris H.)

- Motion to increase fee schedule for memberships as follows: \$40 (family), \$20 (adult), \$20 (youth), \$10 (child), \$5 (individual -trail), \$5 (family trail); need to revise fee policy (including new membership fees) and other policies too

4.2 Motion to appoint John Stephenson as CCNWT representative (Motion: Toby, Second: Sara)
